MEMPHIS NEWS AND NOTES

The new officers of the Memphis Genealogical Society started the year with several projects in mind. Two of these are well on the way to completion. The first was the adoption of a card file system. Several hundred names have been transferred from five generation charts to file cards. You will find a sample card and instructions elsewhere in this bulletin. Please co-operate with us by sending your cards to Mrs. Scott Julian, 868 N. Auburndale, Memphis. When we have received your cards we will have ready access to several thousand surnames from which to exchange data with our members.

Our second project is to copy the burial records for a fifty year period of the oldest existing cemetery in Memphis. Elmwood Cemetery record books reveal the first interment to have taken place in 1853. A few headstones were moved to Elmwood from Winchester Cemetery and some from old Morris Cemetery. The date of the last interment recorded in the second book is 1904.

Your past President, Mrs. L. D. Bejach, and your President accepted an invitation to watch the microfilming of the Shelby County, Tenn. court records that is being done at the courthouse here in Memphis. The stupendous task of filming seven thousand record books, dating from 1821, is under the supervision of Mr. Guy Bates. Miss Gladys Parry, Director, was very thorough and gracious in explaining the details of this operation to us. These valuable records will be available to the public and may be seen in the new record room at the courthouse.

After our visit we went to the office at Elmwood Cemetery to investigate the possibility of our copying their records. We then conceived the idea of having the books microfilmed at the courthouse. After consulting with Mr. Bates, Miss Parry and Mr. Ralph Day, President of Elmwood Association, a plan was presented to the Board of the Elmwood Cemetery Association. If this plan is agreed to, we will soon have another project completed. The microfilmed records will be placed in Cossitt-Goodwyn Library for your use. We sincerely appreciate the spirit of mutual help we encountered all along the way in working out this plan.

A very special vote of thanks is given to our Study Group hostesses. In Feb. the group met in the home of Mrs. Bunyan Webb, 99 Cherokee Dr., and in March we met in the home of Mrs. Thomas L. Robinson, 2115 Hallwood Dr. The study groups offer research exchange and, of equal importance, the opportunity to read rare books and manuscripts. Don't miss this opportunity to exchange information with your fellow members.

In conclusion it seems appropriate to quote from Miss Nellie F. Ayres' book, AYRES KIN AND KIN TO KIN, fresh off the press. In the foreward Miss Nellie says, "If you copy from one book that is plagiarism, from two or more it is research." From half a century of extensive research a very beautiful and useful book has emerged. Congratulations to this Society's newest author.

Query No. "1961 - 79 HART - Could anyone tell me the location of the John M. Hart Cemetery in Henderson Co., Tenn.?" brought the following information from Mr. Russell E. Mooney of Chicago, Illinois:

"My uncle and I were able to get off one day to search out the John M. Hart Cemetery. It is on the Old Jack's Creek Road, about five miles east of Henderson - only about a half mile off the new highway 100.
