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LIBRARY NOTES - The Territorial Papers of the United States

The publication of the *Territorial Papers of the United States* was begun in 1934 under the editorship of Clarence E. Carter. The papers consist of the official records of the Federal Territories, the areas which eventually became states of the Union. The multi-volume work is still in progress, and will eventually include records for all of the territorial units of the continental United States.

From 1790 to 1796, prior to its becoming a state, Tennessee was part of an area known as the Territory South of the River Ohio. The significant papers concerning the Territory South of the River Ohio are compiled in Volume IV of the *Territorial Papers*, and were published in 1936. Volume IV does not include all of the papers which were available for the six-year period, but it does include those documents which were available in the National Archives & the State Archives of North Carolina and Tennessee, as well as various other collections. However, the selection of official papers was drawn principally from the archives of the Departments of State and War, the files of the United States Senate, and the Manuscript Division of the Library of Congress. The material is arranged in chronological sequence, and the entire volume has a complete index of about 30 pages.

Basically the papers fall into two general categories: 1) civil administration and 2) Indian relations. There were few problems concerning the territory's civil administration; therefore, there are not many records in this category. There are no land records in the papers, because the Federal government failed to issue grants in Tennessee.

The Tennessee territorial papers, however, have a large number of documents relating to the Indian policy of the government. These are helpful in understanding the total government policies which led to the removal of the Indians from the state. The records are also valuable tools for those interested in the movement of white settlers into the region.

The papers include a complete copy of the *Journal of the Proceedings of Governor Blount in the Territory South of the Ohio, 1790-1796* which is perhaps of greatest value to the genealogist. In the *Journal* are included numerous names of the early settlers in the territory. The *Journal* is replete with listings of persons appointed to positions in the local militia or in the civil government. In addition, the *Journal* includes the names of persons who were required to obtain licenses from the territorial government. Thus, one will find names of persons authorized to practice law, trade with the Indians, etc.

In conclusion, *The Territorial Papers of the United States*, Volume IV, *The Territory South of the River Ohio, 1790-1796* can be of great assistance to the genealogist researching Tennessee ancestors. Although the volume covers a period from which there is a scarcity of surviving records, many genealogists fail to use it. This could be due, in part, to the fact that in many libraries the *Territorial Papers* are housed in the government publications department. As a result, the work does not appear in the library's card catalog even though most public and academic libraries of medium-to-large size will have the entire set. If you cannot locate the volume in your local library, ask the librarian for assistance. If you have Tennessee ancestors who arrived in the state during its territorial period, you may find this work of great value.

BOOK REVIEWS

WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE, MARRIAGE RECORDS, 1800-1850 *compiled and published by Wilena Roberts Bejach and Lillian Johnson Gardiner. 1957. 296 pages plus index. Order from Gardiner-Bejach, 43 Belleair Drive, Memphis, TN 38104. \$15.00*

This work records more than 5,000 marriages from one of Tennessee's earliest (formed late 1799 from Davidson Co.) and most strategically located counties. In addition to brides', grooms', and bondsmen's names, and dates of license issue, the book lists, when available, the names of persons performing the ceremony and the date of marriage. This book is well-arranged for easy use--marriages are listed alphabetically by grooms' names; brides names are indexed.

THE CENTENNIAL HISTORY OF ARKANSAS, VOLS. I, II, III by Dallas T. Herndon. 1922. Reprinted 1977. Hard backs. Total of over 3366 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., Easley, SC 29640. \$37.50 each volume.

Vol. I recounts the history of Arkansas from French and Spanish ownership up to 1921 with major sections on early days, industry, education, military, and local history. The author makes liberal use of names, especially in the section listing the wars in which Arkansans fought, and in the political history describing presidential campaigns and each gubernatorial administration. Vols. II and III contain biographical sketches through 1923--many of them giving family lines back to the Colonial Period. These are handsome books, individually indexed.

ECHOLS NOTES, VOL. I by Rebecca Echols Terry. 1977. Soft backs. Over 192 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 1414 Monterrey Dr, SE, Huntsville, AL 35801. \$12.00

This book contains marriages, wills and administrations, and census records from VA, NC, SC, TN, AL, and MS collected directly from county records, from census microfilm, from other published works and from correspondents. Every conceivable spelling of the name has been included--63 of them, in fact--from Acles to Eckhoulds. This book can save the searcher for the name months of research time.

BIOGRAPHICAL AND PICTORIAL HISTORY OF ARKANSAS by John Hallum, Vol. I. 1887. Reprinted 1978. Hard back. Over 581 pages. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$25.00

This book, first intended to be a work on the Bench and Bar of Arkansas, grew into a highly readable, almost chatty account of Arkansas' famous and infamous. It is a delight to the historian and genealogist alike, for in the scores of biographical sketches the author has included, he not only records who was kin to whom, but frequently, how that relationship influenced politics. He covers at length the Conway-Rector-Sevier family which has produced numbers of governors of KY, TN, and AR. Most of Mr. Hallum's subjects were born in states east of Arkansas and he meticulously records their parentage, place of birth, education and migration. Typical of his sketches is one on Robert Crockett which tells of Crockett's youthful waywardness, includes vignettes of Crockett's grandfather, Davy, and gives a brief background of the Crockett family in TN. While the book would be more useful to the genealogist if it were truly indexed--the so-called index being, in fact, a detailed table of contents--it is, nevertheless, a gem, a book to be savored.

OUR SILVER HERITAGE by Benjamin Stump Silver and Frances Aylette (Bowen) Silver. 1976. Soft Backs. Over 500 pages. Indexed. Order from Col. (Ret.) Benjamin S. Silver, 123 N. Thirtieth Street, Gatesville, TX 76528. Vol. I, \$30.00

The author has planned to print his family's genealogy in three volumes. The first volume, of which 200 copies were printed, is titled *Gershom & Millicent (Archer) Silver, Their Descendants*; Vol. II will be *Gershom's Colonial Ancestors* and Vol III *English Ancestors, with Thumbnail Sketches of Collateral Harford County MD Families*. Gershom, son of James and Margaret Silver, was born in 1725, and Vol. I contains information on his ancestors and descendants, the name Silver in England and some of the collateral line sketches--Boyd, Chew, Cooper, Harlan, Hoopman, Hopkins, Macklem, Rogers, Stump and Warnock. Many reproductions of family charts and portraits, maps (old and current), old letters, deeds, county records, etc., make this family record most interesting reading.

COWETA COUNTY (GA) CHRONICLES FOR ONE HUNDRED YEARS edited and compiled by Mary G. Jones and Lily Reynolds. 1928. Reprint 1976. Hard backs. Over 890 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmet Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 229, Easley, SC 29640. \$30.00

Coweta Co., GA was formed in 1826 from ceded Creek Indian lands, and lies southwest of Atlanta on the Alabama border. The county is naturally rich in land, timber and minerals, and is rich in Indian and white tradition. The white inhabitants came from the older parts of GA and from the Carolinas, VA and other colonies. Some immigrants were from England, Wales, Scotland, Ireland and other parts of northern Europe. Coweta furnished emigrants to the states west and southwest and to the life and leadership of Ga. It bore a great burden during the Civil War. Many names, marriages, deaths and lineages are mentioned. The index is large, but not complete. Lists of companies of soldiers to the wars contain many names. The description of the life of the people is rich and beautiful. A book to be valued.

EARLY DAYS IN ARKANSAS, Being for the Most Part the Personal Recollections of an Old Settler by Judge William E. Pope, arranged and edited by his son Dunbar H. Pope with an introduction by Hon. Sam W. Williams. 1895. Republished 1978. Hard backs. Over 340 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$22.00

W. F. Pope was a Kentuckian who went to Arkansas as the secretary of his uncle, John Pope, Territorial Governor of Arkansas. In this work, written in his 80th year, he touches on many areas of history and life in general in the territory and the new state. He mentions such events as the first weekly mail route east, the first crafts on Arkansas rivers, the first steamboat, early duels, notables and settlers, finding of gold in Arkansas, his journey west by steamboat to Little Rock, Little Rock in 1832, and much Arkansas memorabilia.

CARROLL COUNTY, TENNESSEE, MARRIAGES, VOL. I, 1838-1859 compiled by the Carroll County Historical Society. 1978. Soft backs. Over 142 pages. Indexed. Order from Carroll County Historical Society, 135 N. Broadway, McKenzie, TN 38201. \$7.00

This work, transcribed from microfilm of Marriage Book A, contains the record of more than 2400 marriages of this west TN county formed in 1821. Marriages are listed alphabetically by grooms' names and the record includes the date of marriage and, where available, the name of the officiant. Bride's names are indexed.

MARRIAGE AND DEATH NOTICES FROM PENDLETON (SC) MESSENGER, 1807-1851 by Brent H. Holcomb. 1976. Hard back. Over 123 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$17.50

The Pendleton Messenger was the first newspaper printed in the "Up Country" of SC, having been established in 1807. The town of Pendleton was the seat of Pendleton District which was abolished in 1828 and ultimately became the counties of Anderson, Pickens, and Oconee. These accounts are of marriages and deaths not only from that up-country area, but reflect those of the entire state because many "Low Country" people summered in Pendleton. Moreover, Pendleton District bordered NC and GA and notices from those states were also printed in the Messenger.

WAKE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA, COURT MINUTES 1777-1784, Book I transcribed by Weynette Parks Haun. 1977. Soft backs. Over 138 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 243 Argonne Dr., Durham, NC 27704. \$15.00

One who has tried to read the old script of County Court Minutes can appreciate Ms. Haun's contribution to genealogists in this book. The original manuscripts of Wake Co. prior to 1777 are missing, but she has transcribed from microfilm these records which are available. Her work is excellent and can be used without difficulty as all surnames are capitalized. As Wake Co. was created in 1771 from Orange, Johnston, and Cumberland Counties, these records could include people from that area.

MY CROSS AND HAND FAMILIES (And my Beeman, Hamrick, Johnson, Page, Poole, Vance, Wells, Williamson, and Woodward Families) by Jeanne Hand Henry. 1977. Soft backs. Over 286 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Genealogical Services, Rt. 2, Box 855, New Market, AL 35761. \$20.00

This compilation by a certified genealogist consists of over 3,000 names, and could be an excellent source for those searchers seeking surnames of people who migrated through the southern states. Sources of information for these migrants were archives, census records, courthouse records, military records, Bible records, personal statements, vital statistics, and recognized publications. Places of origin of the families were Ireland, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia, enroute through Tennessee and Alabama. Other family names were Aiken, Barnett, Brand, Brooks, Calvert, Carpenter, Cashion, Clay, Clearman, Davis, Estes, Fortson, Freeman, Giles, Harrison, Houston, James, Jones, King, Ledlow, Mathews, May, McCann, McMullen, Moore, Munn, Nobles, Price, Pruitt, Reynolds, Rhodes, Smith, Snowden, Stephens, Strange, Tucker, and Walker.

THE ARKANSAS HISTORY COMMISSION BULLETIN OF INFORMATION NOS. 13, 14, 15, 16 by Dallas T. Herndon. 1915. Reprinted 1977. Hard backs. Over 164 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$12.50

The Bulletins are guides to information about Arkansas people. They present in alphabetical sequence several thousand biographical references. The smaller the bulletin number, the earlier the historical reference. The index, prepared by the state history commission, contains information on where original source material can be found; i.e., Abercrombie, J. S., Saline County, Benton Courier, 4-20-1916.

THE 1880 U S CENSUS OF BENTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE *transcribed and published by John C. and Catheryn C. Brown. 1978. Soft backs. Over 217 pages. Indexed. Order from John C. & Catheryn C. Brown, P. O. Box 37, Eva, TN 38333. \$11.00*

This well-compiled, very neat and legible transcription of the Benton County 1880 census is an important addition to genealogical publications on this county. Benton County, in the western part of TN, was created by the legislature late in 1835 from parts of Humphreys and Henry Counties. Settlement had begun in 1819 by settlers principally from VA, NC, SC, and GA. This census is a valuable research tool in that it gives more information than any of the previous censuses.

HISTORICAL REVIEW OF ARKANSAS, VOL I, II, and III *by Fay Hempstead. 1911. Reprinted 1978. Hard backs. Over 1668 pages. Vol. I contains index for all 3 vols. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o The Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$36.00 each volume.*

Vol. I is divided into several major sections, beginning with Colonial to 1803, pre-territorial from 1803 to 1819, territorial from 1819 to 1836, pre-Civil War from 1836 to 1861, Civil War 1861 to 1865, and Reconstruction and growth from 1865 to 1911. Chapters on natural wealth, geography, population, railroads, bench and bar, art, literature, finances, real estate, and city and town building follow. Vols. II and III complete the history with biographical sketches of men who were prominent in the history of Arkansas. About 800 individuals and families are sketched.

THE THIRD AND FOURTH OR 1820 and 1821 LAND LOTTERIES OF GEORGIA *by Rev. Silas Emmett Lucas, Jr. 1973. Hard backs. Over 282 pages. Names are alphabetized by counties. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. Silas Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$37.50*

The Third, or 1820, Georgia Land Lottery was the distribution of lands ceded by the Cherokee and Creek Indians, and consisted of all or part of the counties of Appling, Early, Gwinett, Habersham, Hall, Irwin, Rabun and Walton. These lands were in the north-central part of the state and along the southern border. The Fourth, or 1821, Land Lottery opened that portion of Georgia between the Ocmulgee and Flint Rivers for settlement and extended from today's Roswell on the north to Ashburn on the south. These lands lay in Dooly, Fayette, Henry, Houston and Monroe Counties. This work lists the names of nearly 17,000 recipients, locates their land and county of residence, and often indicates their reason for eligibility--Revolutionary soldier, widow, orphan.

THE LOVELLS COME TO TENNESSEE *by Gordon Aubrey Lovell. 1st edition, second printing. 1976. Hard backs. Over 164 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 2009 Olga Ave., Nashville, TN 37216. \$11.00*

Robert Lovell who came to VA ca 1635 is the ancestor of the author and of James Munroe Lovell who came to Davidson Co., TN ca 1800 from NC. James M. married in Davidson Co. Susannah Pack on 28 July 1808. They settled in Cheatham Co., TN, and reared their six children, who through their marriages add these collateral lines to this family history: Rape, Hollis, House, Hooper, Hows. These marriages occurred between 1828 and 1837, and many more names have been added to the list. Reproductions of many family pictures, documents, charts and maps add to the interesting and informative genealogical history of this family.

LEST WE FORGET, or Character Gems Gleaned from South Arkansas by Rev. J. H. Riggin, D.D., Rev. W. F. Evans, Collaborator. 1910. Reprinted 1978. Hard backs. Over 217 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$22.50

This volume will answer many questions of those interested in early Methodist history of the southern half of Arkansas. It contains biographies of 43 early ministers, and chapters on Austin and Center Point Circuits, Camden and Lakeside (Pine Bluff) Stations, and Walnut Hill Church in Lafayette County. There is also an account of Arkadelphia and Henderson-Brown College, plus three interesting sermons and articles on the Scott and Evans families.

COLUMBUS, GEORGIA 1827-1865 compiled by John H. Martin. 1874. Reprinted 1972. Hard backs. Over 196 pages. Not indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. Silas E. Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$15.00

This chronology of Columbus, GA "from its selection as a 'Trading Town' in 1827 to its partial destruction by Wilson's Raid in 1865" was collected from the recollections of old citizens and abstracts of newspapers. It contains a wealth of information--the marriages, deaths, incidents, personals and lists of businesses and professional men--from the Columbus area. Valuable genealogical material.

THE PEAK-PEAKE FAMILY HISTORY, second installment. Compiled by Cyrus H. Peake, Carol J. Snow and Andrew Guy Peake. 1977. Hard backs. Over 150 pages. Indexed. Order from Cyrus H. Peake, 923 West Bonita Ave., Claremont, CA 91711. \$15.00

This publication is designed to accommodate future installments which may be added within the present binder as they are printed. This second installment gives corrections and additions to the first and introduces four new branches of the family. Vol. I gives a general history of the family in England, including reproductions of paintings and Coats of Arms. Vol. II gives charts of the family in Great Britain. Vol. III, divided into separate books for each branch of the family, gives the descendants of Christopher Peake of Roxbury, Mass., and those of William Peake of Nantucket Island, Mass. Vol. IV deals with Peakes in Australia. Each book is indexed. It is now possible to acquire only those volumes or books in which purchasers are especially interested along with Vol. I, which is of essential interest to all family members.

THE BELLS IN U. S. A. AND ALLIED FAMILIES 1650-1977 by Getha Gina Bell. 1977. Hard backs. Over 766 pages. Indexed. Order from The Bells in the USA, 2980 Holiday Cl., Buford, GA 30518. \$30.00

The Bells--at least most of them--were from Scotland, and the author of this work has uniquely presented them and their seven centuries of Scottish records. She has classified the Bells into three groups--Lowland Scots, Highland Scots, and Ulster Scots--and has listed as many of the original emigrants as possible, connecting them with their present-day descendants. Parts One, Two, and Three list Bell families in America, among them the descendants of the emigrants James Bell of Augusta Co., VA; Wm. Bell of VA, TN, and AL; Thomas Bell of VA and TN; Evander Bell of NC; Walter Bell of PA and NC; and Wm. Bell of SC and GA. Part Four consists of biographies, soldiers of the American Revolution, wills and deeds; and Part Five consists of allied families.

INDEX TO WILLS OF MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA 1808-1900 by Andrew Ezell Terry, Ph.D. 1977. Soft covers. Over 37 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, P. O. Box 206, Huntsville, AL. \$4.50

Dr. Terry has given genealogists with roots in the Tennessee Valley area a wonderful tool of the trade. His neat little book of around 1000 wills (one of John Phelps probated first in Halifax Co. VA 27 Jan 1794, and registered in Madison Co. AL 11 Feb 1847) lists alphabetically anyone about whom there is any available probate record, giving date of probate, book and page number. He has researched wills from deed books, probate records, probate minutes, will books, chancery court records, orphans court records, and a volume called 1818-1820 of mixed minutes, wills, inventories, etc. When the decedent was a resident of another county or state, that is noted. Many times he has given the heirs. There are fifteen references to the state of Tennessee.

MARRIAGE AND DEATH NOTICES FROM UPPER S. C. NEWSPAPERS, 1843-1865 abstracted by Brent Holcomb C.R.S. 1977. Hard covers. Over 168 pages. Indexed. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$17.50

These abstracts are from all of the newspapers which could be located from the districts of Spartanburg, Laurens, Newberry and Lexington, SC before 1866. As marriages were not recorded by SC before 1911, these newspaper records of marriages and obituaries are especially important to the genealogist. The notices are from all over the state as well as from the adjoining states of NC and GA and of persons who had left the state and gone to AL, MS, TX, CA and other states.

ABSTRACTS OF OLD NINETY-SIX AND ABBEVILLE DISTRICT WILLS AND BONDS as on file in the Abbeville, SC Courthouse, compiled by Willie Pauline Young. 1950. Reprinted 1977 with complete index. Order from Southern Historical Press, c/o Rev. S. Emmett Lucas, Jr., P. O. Box 738, Easley, SC 29640. \$25.00

Old Ninety-Six District, settled by the Scotch-Irish, the English, the French Huguenots, and some Germans, was split in 1798 to form the new districts of Abbeville, Edgefield, Newberry, Laurens and Spartanburg. These abstracts, therefore, made from the original papers found in the probate judge's office, can refer to people who later are found to be living in the new districts. The town of Ninety-Six was the seat of the courts of the old district and after the realignment of districts was located in Abbeville District. The records of Old Ninety-Six are, therefore, now to be found in the courthouse (those records, that is, not found in the State Archives) of Abbeville County.

COBB AND COBBS, EARLY VIRGINIANS by John E. Cobb, Jr. 1976. Hard backs. Over 128 pages. Indexed. Order from Durant Publishing Co., 1208 Tatum Court, Alexander, VA 22307. \$10.00

The author presents the Cobbs in a most interesting, readable, witty way. He tells of their pre-Anglo-Saxon English origins, the first Cobb families in VA, and their migration south and west into NC, SC, GA, TN, KY and elsewhere. He refers to their royal connections and marriages to the "first families" of VA, and has a section on notable Cobbs. His presentation of 13 generations of American Cobbs in 12 charts is at once easily understood and concise. More than a "who begat whom" book, this little book is almost a "must" for Cobbs and Cobb kin.

Georgia material in the Winter 1978 issue includes tombstone records from Baldwin County, marriage records from Bibb and Emanuel Counties, bond book records from Cobb County, newspaper excerpts, a new list of soldiers (Battle of Kettle Creek), and Lincoln County grantor deed index. South Carolina material in this same issue has Revolutionary War pension applications in Laurens County and deed book records from Union County.

Issue No. 4 of Volume 38 continues presentation of "Chester Smith's Journal 1852," written as he traveled from Michigan to California. The "CGS Bulletin Board", a regular feature, is a concise and easy-to-read listing of names being researched by the membership.

Volume 18, No. 1, January 1978, offers pedigree charts of members; news of the society; membership list; wills and indentures of Fleming County, KY; and a review of other publications received by the society. \$5.00 annually.

FAMILY TRAILS. Quarterly of The Historical and Genealogical Association of Mississippi, 618 Avalon Road, Jackson, MS 39206. Dues are \$7.50 (single) or \$10.00 (family). This is a new society founded in June of 1977. Issue No. 3 of Volume 1, February 1978, has marriages, cemetery records, newspaper excerpts, deeds and wills, Bible and lineage records from counties scattered throughout the state with a sprinkling of records from Texas and Alabama. Of special note is an article on "Places with other Names" which lists some Mississippi communities along with their former names and a capsule history of each.

LOCAL COLOR

by Betsy F. West

The language of early deeds frequently paints a vivid picture of the wilderness our pioneer fathers had to tame. These words from a Warren County deed dated 4 July 1818 are an example:

"...a certain tract or parcel of land laying and being in the county of Warren and third District on the waters of Collins' river and bounded as follows: Beginning on a stake ten poles south east course from a small spring on the top of the Mountain. Thence North twenty poles to the brow of the Bluff of the Mountain to a stake. Thence west sixty-three poles to a sourwood tree. Thence East sixty-four poles to a Black Gum and Chesnut. Thence North forty-three poles to the beginning."

And picture this homestead as described in another deed:

"...beginning at the head of spring or on a stake in the middle of Collins River, against the spring a little above where Hill's road crosses the river now the using spring where Isaac Hill, Sr. lives, and running thence eastwardly with what is now called Hill's road about 100 poles to the foot of the mountains or against what is called the wheat field or peach orchard, thence north with the meanders of the mountains about one hundred and fifty poles to a spring in the gap between the river and big sink, including said spring, thence westwardly with the mountains and Brown's line to the river, thence southwardly up the river with its meanders to the beginning."

TENNESSEE NEWS ITEMS FROM THE CATAWBA JOURNAL, CHARLOTTE, MECKLENBURG COUNTY, NC
Contributed by Floyd L. Simpson, Jr.

April 4, 1826 - Married in Lincoln on March 28 by Rev. James M'Bee, Dr. George F. Graham of Memphis, W. Tenn. to Miss Martha Ann Harris.

August 8, 1826 - Died in Greene Co., Tenn. on July 16 age 25 years, Mr. James E. Robinson. Mr. Robinson was born and raised in Lincoln Co., N. C.; he was on a tour to the west when he was taken with a fever on Aug. 29, 1825; by assistance he was enabled to get on towards home as far as Greene Co. where he died.

August 8, 1826 - Departed this life in 28th year of his age at Hickory Grove, Burke Co., N. C. on 30th of June at 10 o'clock P. M., Col. John B. Tate. He was sick with a pulmonary disease for 3 years. A short period before his death he had united himself in marriage to the amiable and accomplished Miss Webster of Tennessee.

May 8, 1827 - Obit. - A little girl, daughter of Sarah Brooks near Nashville, Tenn. age about 6 years was a few days ago burnt to death by the accidental communication of fire to her clothes.

October 30, 1827 - Married in this town on Thursday evening last by Rev. Mr. Robinson, Mr. Marshall T. Polk of Tennessee to Miss Laura T. Wilson, daughter of Joseph Wilson, Esq.

November 13, 1827 - Died at Memphis, Tenn. on 27th of Sept. last, Doct. George Franklin Graham, son of Gen. Joseph Graham of Lincoln County, North Carolina. Dr. Graham after graduating at our university and receiving the honours of the Medical College in New York removed directly to the west and by his attainments and energy took high rank in his profession.
