



My husband's father, Marius Jensen Nygaard, was from Herning, Denmark. He served in the Danish navy before moving to the United States where he later married my husband's mother, Lois Marie McClurkin of Arkansas. She died when my husband was ten years old.

In 1981, my husband's maiden aunt, who had the family Bible and photograph album, died. As sometimes happens, a family member grabbed both the Bible and album before the funeral, and we have not seen either since. My only regret was the album contained the 1927 newspaper article and picture of my late mother-in-law in her lovely wedding dress. My daughter, her only grandchild, did not know what her paternal grandmother looked like.

After Marius Jensen Nygaard's death in 1985, I wrote to the public records depositories in Copenhagen and Herning, Denmark in search of his naval record. To my disappointment, they wrote back and said that there were no records. However, a few weeks later I received a letter from a woman in Denmark which stated that my letter to the Herning public record depository had been published in the newspaper there. She said that she was a relative, and wanted to know about the American family. In response, I wrote her a very long letter.

Some weeks later, on St. Valentine's Day, the postman arrived at my home with a package from Denmark. Inside was a ten by fourteen hand colored portrait of my husband's mother in her lovely wedding dress (it is the only picture we have of her). Needless to say, it was a very special Valentine's Day.

UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE MEDICAL FACULTY OF 1902 - Submitted by Madeline Cullison 4820 W. Alice, Glendale, Arizona 85302

Among a packet of Civil War materials she ordered from the National Archives, Mrs. Cullison found a certification of marriage on a letterhead of the University of Tennessee Medical School in Nashville. John A. Vickery and Louisa Hart were married on November 4, 1876 by J. Bunyan Stephens, Clergyman of the Primitive Baptist Church. It was notarized on 20 May 1902 by J. G. Eubank, Notary Public of Nashville. A statement written below Mr. Stephens' signature says "My age is 66 years & address is 32 Rutledge St., Nashville, Tenn."

ESTATE AND FAMILY OF MICHAEL BURKE - Memphis and Shelby County Archives 33 S. Front St., Memphis, TN 38103

A petition, No. 4667 - 1878, filed by John Loague, Public Administrator, (June 1885) to the Probate Court of Shelby County, Tennessee, on behalf of Father Bloomer, Treasurer of St. Peter's Church refers to the estate and surviving family of one Michael Burke, who departed this life in 1878. Father Bloomer affirmed (Nov. 9, 1882) that Michael Burke left no immediate living survivors, having neither wife nor children, having never been married. Michael Burke had on deposit at the church, three hundred dollars, as churches of the time sometimes acted as bankers for the parishoners.

Michael Burke was survived by the children of a sister, Mary Ellen Burke Bohlen, spouse of John Bohlen, both deceased. Mary Ellen Burke Bohlen died in 1874 in Memphis and her husband John Bohlen died in 1877. The children were Mary Ellen Bohlen, age 19 of 184 Winchester, Memphis, TN; Michael Bohlen, age 20, somewhere "down the river;" and Patrick Bohlen, age 29, somewhere in St. Paul, MN. Two other sisters of Michael Burke were both deceased, one Catherine or Kate, unmarried, who died in Memphis in 1878, and Mary who had remained in Ireland was also deceased.

Affidavits were obtained and presented to the Court supporting the right of Mary Ellen Bohlen to inherit the money on deposit at St. Peter's Church. Those giving the affidavits were:

- Mrs. Mary Hurley and her dau, Mrs. Jane Carroll, of 35 Manassas, stated they knew the Burke and Bohlen families and that Mary Ellen Bohlen was the only living relative of known address.
- Mrs. Jane Carroll of 13 Manassas stated in her deposition of June 1885 that she had known both families since 1861, and the facts as stated were true.
- Mrs. Catherine O'Gere, widow of Bernard O'Gere, of 108 Winchester Avenue, gave a deposition (June 1885) supporting the above facts, and stating that Michael Burke was often at her brother's (Wm. Sherley's) house.
- Mary Ellen Bohlen also made affidavit (February 1885) that she was the only surviving relative of known address. * * *

PUTNAM COUNTY, TENNESSEE 1855 TAX LIST Transcribed by Jane Park Paessler from Tennessee State Library and Archives Microfilm, Tax Lists Roll No. 7

Putnam County, Tennessee was created in 1854 out of White, Jackson, Overton and DeKalb Counties, making this it's first tax list. It is taken from the film of a typed copy of the original list, which may account for some obvious misspelling. In addition to the usual categories a "personality" tax was levied. Page number 48 on the microfilm roll was missing.

CIVIL WAR BIOGRAPHIES Compiled by Mary Louise Graham Nazor (Continued from Winter 1994)

The original 1899 publication of Confederate Military History was a twelve volume set edited by Gen Clement A Evans of Georgia. About a third of each volume contains the Civil War history of that Southern State, and the last two-thirds gives biographical sketches and War experiences of general officers, privates & patriotic citizens. This history was a subscription set, and a prospectus of about twenty pages was circulated in early 1896. A person signed a contract for the \$48 cloth or \$60 half-leather set of books. At that time, the subscribers were asked to send biographical information to be included. At a later date, the Confederate Veterans Magazine sold the sets for half price so that the average man could afford it.

In the original set, Volume VII contained the Tennessee data. Since a full set of the 1899 version is rare, there was a 1987 Reprint Extended Edition of seventeen volumes (each state a separate volume) plus a two volume index.

Only genealogical information was abstracted from the biographies, each of which is usually one printed page, however some are more. Each man gave his Civil War record in his own words, but when a veteran was deceased, a relative or friend wrote the biography. These personal accounts are very detailed, containing many poignant stories. All locales given are in Tennessee unless otherwise noted.

BUCHANAN, Capt Joseph W - born 29 Dec 1841 Chatham Co NC; son of Thomas J Buchanan and Sophia Martin (both born NC of Scotch descent); family to Chickasaw Co MS in 1842; he was admitted to the bar in 1869; 1870-88 practiced law at Okolona, MS; to Memphis about 1889; married Thelia Spragins; has six children living

BUFORD, Edward - born 1842 Williamson Co TN; lives in Nashville where he has been in business over 30 years

BUIST, John R, MD - born 13 Feb 1834 Charleston, SC; eldest child of Rev Edward T Buist, Presbyterian clergy; grandfather was Rev George Buist of Scotland who went to Charleston in 1792 and died in 1808; he was reared in Greenville, SC; in 1857 at University of New York Medical Department; 1858-59 at University of Edinburgh; 1860 to Nashville; brother Dr Edward S Buist; later to Maury Co; his son is Dr William E Buist; resides in Nashville

CAGE, Jesse - born 30 Jan 1841 Sumner Co; to Nashville in 1886

CAIN, Maj John Savelly, M.D. - born 1832 Sumner Co TN; graduated medical school in 1853; practiced in Pontotoc, MS; 1882 to Nashville; since 1893 professor at the University of the South at Sewanee

CALDWELL, James A - born Chickamauga Park; an attorney in Chattanooga who graduated in law at the University of Virginia in 1867; married Lizzie Gillespie who was the daughter of George L Gillespie, and niece of Col J W Gillespie and sister of Gen George L Gillespie; they had three children: Percy A, Rhobie and Elsie

CANNON, Capt Waynne G - born 24 Jul 1844 Clarksville; son of Monroe Cannon; mother was a descendent of Thomas Kilgour who was the first white settler of Robinson (Robertson?) Co; at age ten he moved to Memphis

CAPERS, Richard S - born 21 Jun 1847 Haywood Co; son of Rev Benjamin H Capers, DD, LLD of South Carolina and clergy in the Methodist Episcopal Church; his brother is Bishop William Capers and uncle of Bishop Ellison Capers of South Carolina; his mother was Rebecca J Greaves who married again in 1849; Richard married 1884 Alice J Tapscott of Marshall Co MS; they have a son and a daughter

CARROLL, Capt John W - born 28 Nov 1841 Henderson Co; son of William Carroll and grandson of Joseph Carroll from South Carolina to Lincoln Co about 1806 (he was son of a Revolutionary Soldier who came to America about 1770); Joseph was a soldier at the Battle of New Orleans; John W was in Kentucky a year after the War; Married 1871 Mary S Galbraith; his son is Thomas B Carroll

CARROLL, William H - born 1842 Panola Co MS; son of Brig Gen William H Carroll; grandson of William Carroll of Pennsylvania who moved to Nashville in 1810, was in the Creek Wars and Governor of TN 1821-1833; William H is an attorney in Memphis

CARTER, Col James E - born 1828 Knox Co; after the War was an agent for New York house; settled in Knoxville in 1877

CARTER, Joel W - born 1843 Lawrence Co AL; after the War in Leighton then Florence, AL and then in Nashville in 1870; President of First National Bank of Nashville

CARUTHERS, Stoddert - born 21 Feb 1845 Jackson, TN; son of James Caruthers and Frances McCorry; his grandfather Joseph Caruthers, was in the Revolutionary War; he graduated in law in 1867; married Ella C Brown, daughter of Judge Milton Brown of Jackson

CAULK, Shelby V - born 1 Oct 1844 Desha Co AR; to Memphis in 1874 but traveled in Arkansas on business

CHASE, Irvine K - born 1843 Laurens Dist SC; raised in Washington DC; after war was in business at Richmond, Baltimore and the last thirty years in Nashville

CHEATHAM, Maj John A - born 6 Jun 1826 Nashville; he was the fifth of eleven children of Leonard Pope Cheatham; two brothers were Benjamin Franklin and Felix Robertson Cheatham; his father was a lawyer, in the Indian Wars and a Postmaster in Nashville; his mother was descended from Gen James Robertson; his grandfather Andrew Cheatham to Robertson County from Virginia; when John A was age twenty he and brother Frank went to Arkansas but returned a few years later; back to AR Jun 1852; he moved to Memphis Jan 1882 and married Mrs Charlott Wall Cheatham, widow of a kinsman

CHEEK, Thomas H - born 1836 Rappahannock Co Virginia; father was Elijah Cheek and grandfather was George Cheek of North Carolina; he had a mill at Marietta, Georgia (Cook & Cheek) then Kenesaw Mills until 1887 when he moved to Chattanooga; married 1859 Mary M Reid of Moulton, Alabama; they had a daughter Mary who married Arthur E Davinport

CHENEY, Maj Hampton Johnson - born 1836 in Cheneyville, Rapides Parish LA; father died when he was an infant; his mother, who was from Virginia, moved to Nashville to raise him; he married Amanda Stratton, daughter of Col Madison Stratton

CHILDRESS, Capt John Whitsitt - born 20 Apr 1845 Murfreesboro, TN; went to Nashville in 1880; a Judge of Second Circuit Court

CHILTON, Thomas Harding - born 3 Feb 1842 Benton County (now Calhoun) AL; ancestors from Virginia; father Dr Rezin Rawlings Chilton was born Rhea Co TN and married Mary Harding of Alabama then moved to Mississippi; grandfather was Pelatich Chilton born 1791 in Virginia and married 16 Mar 1809 Elizabeth Rawlings in Overton Co TN; Thomas was a partner in a Memphis drugstore and in 1871 married Blanche M Blair; their two children are David Blair and Allie Chilton

CLARK, George S - born 1827 Nashville; owned a ranch in Texas; after the war he farmed in Sumner Co TN until 1871 then moved to Nashville

CLARK, Micajah Henry - born 4 Sep 1830 Richmond, VA; he married 30 Jul 1861 Elizabeth Watts Kerr of Lynchburg, VA; their children are Lucy Norvell who married Edward S Munford, Morris Kerr who married first Frances Pendleton Barker and married second Cornelia Saunders; Micajah was descended from Capt Christopher Clark who was in Barbados in 1680 and went to Virginia about 1700 (Note: extensive family genealogy)

CLAYBROOKE, Maj Frederick - born 21 Sep 1837 Willliamson Co TN; son of Col John S Claybrooke; he was killed 24 Jun 1863

CLEARY, James E - born 2 Jun 1844 County Clare, Ireland; his parents were Patrick and Helen Cleary who came to America in 1844 and died in 1852; married after the war and had eight children; he was a former fire chief in Memphis

CLIFT, Col Moses H - born 25 Aug 1836 Soddy, Hamilton Co TN; his father was William C Clift who went to Knoxville with his father in childhood and settled in Hamilton County in 1825 (wife Nancy Arwin, daughter of Gen Moses Brooks of Knoxville and in Rev War); a brother is J W Clift; Moses married 1866 Attie Cooke, who died 1876 and was the daughter of Dr R F Cooke; Moses married second 1883 to Florence Parrott, daughter of Judge J R Parrott of Cartersville, GA; he has six living children. Col Clift is descended from James Clift, an Englishman who went to North Carolina in 1712 (his son James was in Rev War)

COCHRAN, John F, MD - born 14 Oct 1845 Cocke Co TN; one ancestor is Capt Shields; John F moved to Memphis in 1868 and graduated from Memphis Medical College in 1871; he married 1872 Mattie Mercer; they had one son and two daughters; the first fifteen years of practice were spent in Bartlett, TN and in 1886 he moved to Memphis

COCHRAN, Capt John W - born 24 May 1835 Washington Co TN/VA; died 14 Jan 1899; he was son of Conley Cochran and Nancy Cassidy who married in Ireland and went first to

Virginia and then to Memphis in 1844; John W was the youngest of thirteen children; 20 Dec 1866 he married Ida C Williams (born in Memphis, daughter of Joseph C and Lavinia Rogerson Williams, she born North Carolina)

COCKRILL, Capt Mark Sterling - born 29 May 1838 Davidson Co TN; a graduate of Western Military Institute in 1859; married 20 May 1865 at Salem, NC to Mary H Goodloe, daughter of John Calvin Goodloe of Alabama

COLE, Capt Edmund A - born 5 Dec 1824 Giles Co TN; son of David Robinson Cole, born in Bedford Co VA; Edmund married Mary Anderson, daughter of Robert, an officer of the Rev War who went to Kentucky then to Tennesseee and then to Mississippi where he died; a brother of his wife is Samuel R Anderson; his brothers are Andrew J, Samuel A and Robert A Cole; Edmund went to California in 1849 for two years after being in the Mexican War; came to Memphis in 1857 and survived the yellow fever epiemics of 1873 and 1878

COLE, William R, MD - born in 1837 Chatham Co NC; his father Herbert C Cole, born in North Carolina, died in 1863

COLLIER, Charles H - born 25 Aug 1846 Hampton VA; son of Charles M Collier of Virginia; been in Memphis since 1872

COLLIER, Col Cowles Myles - born in Hampton VA; after the war he married Hannnah Shackleford of Georgia and was there until 1871 when he moved to Memphis; in 1891 he moved to New York City; their children are Mrs Edwart T Comer of Savannah, GA, Mrs W W Stewart of Columbus, GA, C M Collier and Barron G Collier

COLLIER, William Armistead - born 12 Feb 1847 Haywood Co TN; son of Thomas Barksdale Collier and Catherine Page Nelson from Virginia; moved to Memphis 1870; married 1872 Alice Trezevant, daughter of Nathaniel Macon Trezevant and Amanda Avery of Memphis; they had four children (*lots of early genealogical data*)

COLVILLE, Lt Richard W, MD - born 1843 Warren Co TN; reared in Rhea Co TN; his father was Capt Warner E Colville; he graduated from Nashville Medical College in 1868 and practiced nineteen years in Washington, TN; married 1869 Mary L Paine who died in 1896; three living children, Orville E, Frederich E and Young E Colville; lives in Hill City, suburb of Chattanooga

CONDON, John - born 1827 County Clare, Ireland; came to America in 1846 to Springfield, Mass; from there to Hartford, Conn, New Haven, Conn and then to Charlottesville, VA until 1857 when he went to Rogersville, TN; died in Knoxville 1887; married 1844 in Ireland to Bridget Gray; four sons are Michael J, James J, Stephen P of Knoxville and Martin J of Nashville (born 1846)

COOK, Capt Henry Howe - born 23 Nov 1843 Williamson Co TN; entered the bar at Franklin, TN in 1867

COOLEY, James L - born 3 Feb 1845 Rogersville, TN; moved to Knoxville in 1871

COOLEY, Theodore - born 1842 Nashville, TN

COOPER, Capt Lunsford Pitts - born 8 Jun 1830 Rutherford Co TN; descends from Henry Cooper, a Maryland Rev War soldier who lived in Salisbury, NC; Lunsford graduated in

 $1852\ {\rm from}$ Union University at Murfreesboro and taught school several years then moved to Panola Co MS and to Memphis in 1875

COUSINS, Lt Peter Robinson - born 16 Jun 1832 Nottaway Co VA; son of Capt William H Cousins; moved to Memphis in 1856

COWAN, James Benjamin, MD - born 15 Sep 1831 Fayetteville, TN; from Scotch ancestry who emigrated to Londonderry, Ireland then to Virginia before the Rev War; his grandfather Maj James Cowan was reared in Blount Co TN and died in 1815 (married Mary Walker); Maj James was one of the first settlers in Franklin Co in 1806; father of James B was Samuel Montgomery Cowan born 1801 Blount Co. (1822 clergyman Cumberland Presbyterian Church); married Nancy C Clements, daughter of Maj Benjamin Clements and Sarah Brazeale of South Carolina; Maj Benjamin Clements was a brother to Gen Jesse B Clements; James B lived in Horn Lake, MS and Memphis until 1851 then returned to Fayetteville; practiced medicine in Meridianville and Memphis; after the war he went from Alabama to Memphis until 1866 then to Franklin Co TN; in 1870-73 in Selma, AL then Tullahoma, TN; married 20 Oct 1857 Huntsville, AL to Lucy Robinson, daughter of James B Robinson; Lucy's mother was Frances Otey of Virginia, daughter of Capt Otey (in War of 1812) and cousin to Bishop Otey

COX, Col Nicholas Nichols - born 6 Jan 1837 Bedford Co TN; his father was Caleb Cox who died when he was an infant; mother moved to Arkansas then followed two elder sons to southwest Texas and in 1847 reached Seguin near San Antonio (one son still living Gonzales Co TX); Col Nicholas and mother returned to Tennessee; he graduated from law school in 1858 in Lebanon then located in Linden, TN; married 6 Jan 1859 Mary Slayden of Hickman Co TN; they had two sons and two daughters; after war to Franklin, TN

CRAIGMILES, John Henderson - born 7 Jun 1825 Greene Co TN; son of Joseph H and Bathsheba Craigmiles; his grandfather was of Scotch ancestry and came to Tennessee from Cynthiana, KY, then with an elder brother to Dalton, GA for three years; traveled much and to Cleveland, TN in 1856; married 18 Dec 1860 M. Adelia Thompson, daughter of Dr. G B Thompson; only daughter Nina died in childhood; John died before this book was published

CUNNINGHAM, Sumner A - born 21 Jul 1843 Bedford Co TN; after war settled in Shelbyville; in 1876 he purchased the Chattanooga Times and sold it in 1880; went to New York for one year then back to Nashville, TN

DALLAS, Capt Trevanion Barlow - born 11 Sep 1843 Washington, DC; son of Commodore A J Dallas and Mary Byrd Willis; his grandfathers were Alexander James Dallas, Secretary of Treasury & War under President Madison, and Dr Barlow of the Church of England. After the war he was in Pensacola for six months and then went to France to vist an aunt, Princess Murat, wife of Prince Achille (served in Prussian Army) who was son of King of Naples and Caroline Bonaparte; went to New York in 1868 then went into banking in Charlottesville, VA until late 1869 when he moved to Nashville

DASHIELL, Capt George - born 10 Jan 1828 Maryland; son of Rev A H Dashiell, a Presbyterian Minister, and Ann Ridgely, daughter of Judge Richard Ridgely of Maryland; his grandfather was Rev George Dashiell of French Huguenot descent and first rector of St. Peters Episcopal Church in Baltimore; moved to Nashville in 1838 with parents; moved to Memphis in 1846 and married 1856 Tate Edmundson, daughter of Capt A J Edmundson, War of 1812; she died 1878 of yellow fever, leaving three children Civil War Biographies (continued)

DAVIS, Sam - born 6 Oct 1842 at Stewart's Creek near Smyrna, Rutherford Co TN; son of Charles L Davis and Jane Simmons; he was hung as a spy

DEADERICK, Chalmers, MD - born 1847 Knoxville TN; he took the place of a sick brother in the Confederate Service; brothers Robert V, Inslee and Oakley Deaderick; after war spent four years at Washington & Lee University and graduated at medical school of University of Pennsylvania in 1871

DeLAUNAY, Lt James R - born 1842 Milledgeville, GA; reared in Shelby Co TN; married 1879 Mrs Laura Hollowell (nee Culpeper); she died in 1892 leaving one daughter; now lives in Collierville, TN

DICKINSON, Laurence Thomsen - born 21 Jun 1843 Cumberland Co MD; son of William Dickinson of Baltimore; moved to Chattanooga 1881

DICKSON, Augustus F - born 1832 Williamson Co TN; son of Thomas Dickson and Jane Moore; his grandfather was Thomas Dickson who was born 1791 in Lincoln Co NC of Scotch-Irish descent; mother from North Carolina; he was educated in Gibson Co TN; married 29 Nov 1866 to Laura McCutcheon, daughter of John D. McCutcheon; lives in Newbern, TN

DILLARD, Lt John W - born 12 Dec 1837 Newberry District SC; reared in Cass Co GA; in 1856 in business in Ponotoc Co MS; now lives in Memphis

DISMUKES, D J - born 1837 Summer Co TN; eldest son of W M Dismukes of Virginia and Judith A Burke of Kentucky; his grandfather, Paul Dismukes of Virginia, was an early settler of Tennessee; after war D J went home near Gallatin; married 1867 Rebecca Donelson, daughter of Gen D S Donelson

DISMUKES, Lt John L - born 4 Mar 1844 Davidson Co; went to Nashville 1870

DOAK, Lt Henry Melvil - born 3 Aug 1841 Washington Co TN; educated at Washington College and Stewart College at Clarksville, TN; after war went to Shreveport, LA and studied law; returned to Clarksville

DONALDSON, Capt William E - born 25 Aug 1842 Franklin Co TN; from 1871 to 1878 was a lawyer in Alabama; now an attorney at Jasper, TN

DONELSON, Maj Gen Daniel S - his father Samuel Donelson was born in Sumner Co a son of a native of Ireland and early settler of Tennessee, who died at age twenty-four leaving two sons - Daniel S and Andrew Jackson Donelson; his aunt Rachel married Andrew Jackson (she died 1869); Daniel married about1827 to Margaret Branch daughter of Governor John Branch (Gov of NC); they had four sons and seven daughters(sons James B, Samuel, John Branch and Daniel S)

DONELSON, Richard S - born 1 Aug 1844 Arlington, Shelby Co TN; son of Alexander Donelson born in Davidson Co, and Catherine S Royster of Virginia; Richard married 1874 Fannie C Bragg who died in 1889; two sons and two daughters living

DOUGLAS, Byrd - born 1849, native of Fayetteville, TN; because he had lost one eye in childhood, was not regularly enlisted, but was accepted as a volunteer in 1862, serving till end of war *(to be continued)*

GIBSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE ADMINISTRATORS' BONDS, REPORTS AND SETTLEMENTS 1824-1833

Original documents known as loose papers may reveal heretofore unknown facts about an ancestor. The facts listed in this article were taken from hundreds of time-yellowed, stained, sometimes torn or smoked, pieces of paper in every size. They frequently give an inventory of the property of the deceased, which would include the name of the administrator and possibly family connections, as well as insight into the life style of an individual. The names of the people who bought at the sale of his property could indicate other members of his family, friends or neighbors. Commissioners were appointed by the court to audit an Administrator's report, which might reveal the names of the heirs, however, the contents of each estate are not consistant, and sometimes only the Commissioners were identified.

Gibson County was formed from the Western District in 1823, and by 1824 the court system was established. At some later date, the loose papers of each estate were bundled together, and eventually the bundles were placed in boxes by decades. Occasionally, an administration will continue into the next decade before it is settled, and the loose papers will be divided into two boxes. We have combined two of the earliest boxes (the Bonds box and the Reports & Settlements box), unfolding, cleaning, sorting and abstracting each document and have placed them in acid-free folders.

The abstract of Gibson County estate papers begins with an assigned number, followed by the date of the earliest document (when given) and the Book and page numbers of the original filing in Gibson County. Identification of a person's role in the estate is given in the column beside his name. There are no names beginning with "A" in this time period.

ROANE COUNTY, TENNESSEE COURT MINUTES, VOLUME A, June 1803 - Sep 1807 Abstracted from Tennessee State Library and Archives Microfilm (Continued from Winter 1994)

- p. 276 John Den vs John Dudley: A case, begun in Nov 1802 and involving also Richard Fen, concerning boundary disputes is dismissed for lack of further prosecution.
- p. 277 James Masters, Assignee vs Robert Shadden: Trespass. A case begun in November 1803 was continued and is now dismissed for lack of further prosecution.

Thomas Humes vs William Barnett & John Smith T.: Debt. James Trimble, attorney for Humes, appeared in June court 1804 with his declaration and the case was continued. The defendants appeared in Sept court and acknowledged a lesser sum of debt and the court ruled in favor of Humes, who agreed to stay the execution of this judgement for three months.

- p. 278 John Den vs David Moore & Isaac Shinalt: Trespass & Ejectment. A suit begun in May 1804 and involving Richard Fen, is dismissed by Den.
- p. 279 William Gardenhire, assignee of James Gallaher vs John Stone: Debt. Stone acknowledged the debt and Gardenhire agreed to stay the execution until June 1805.
- p. 280 David Bailey, constable, returned an execution issued by George Preston, Esqr, JP for Roane County, in favor of John Smith T. against Annesly Clark for \$50.50. Bailey marked the paper "Executed (on) the track of land where Annesly Clark lives supposed to be fifty acres." On motion of John Smith T, the court ordered the land to be sold to satisfy the debt.

Court adjourned till Court in Course.

- p. 299 Edward Scott vs Peter Avery: Debt. Avery came into court and acknowledged the debt of \$50.00. Scott acknowledged satisfaction for \$13.00 "and directs the Execution not to Issue for the Balance of Judgement till he gives orders."
- p. 300 William Lamkin vs John Wadd<u>ls</u>: Debt. The defendant acknowledged his debt and was given six months to pay the principle & interest at six per cent.
- p. 301 Peter A. Vandorn vs Alexander Hopkins: Trespass. This suit was originally brought up in October 1804, and the sheriff returned "not to be found in my County" on Hopkins. Vandorn did not appear to prosecute in December court and the suit was dismissed.

Reuben Smith vs Jacob Fry: Trespass. In November 1804 the Sheriff served a paper on the defendant, Jacob Fry, which he marked "Executed 8th Dec 1804, Dismissed by order of Plaintiff, and John Smith T assumes the costs."

p. 302 - Julius Hocker vs John Cleives: Trespass. The attorney for Hocker and Cleives himself appeared in December court. Cleives agreed to pay the court costs and Hocker dropped the suit.

John Den vs John Flatt: Trepass. Suit dismissed.

- p. 303 Alexander Hopkins vs William Davidson: Appeal. Additional names mentioned in the suit are: Jacob Jones, JP., William Barnett, JP., N. Paschall, Const., William Byrn, William Gallaher & Walter Davidson, George W. King, James Trimble, Esq.
- p. 304 John Humphreys vs George Rowlin: Appeal. Additional names in the suit are: Isham Cox, JP., J. Jones, JP., Thomas Shy, & William B. McNutt, Atty.
- p. 305 State vs Adam Sherral: Neglect as Overseer. In September 1804, the sheriff was ordered to bring Sherr<u>ell</u> into court to answer the charge. The sheriff returned a "not found" report. Again in October the Sheriff reported "not found." The attorney for the state dropped the suit.

State vs Roger Gideon: Neglect as Overseer. In a suit similar to the one above, the sheriff returned "Executed 21st September 1804" and the case was continued to December, but the Prosecutor dropped the suit.

<u>GLENN and KIN Descendants of James Glen of Hanover County, Virginia 1717-1993</u> by Jeannette May Christopher. 1994. Revised & updated edition. Hardback, 6x9, 648 pp. Full name index. Order from Annie Glenn Howell, c/o Genealogy Publishing Service, 448 Ruby Mine Road, Franklin, NC 28734. \$45.00 plus \$4.50 p&h. NC residents please add \$2.40 sales tax.

This account of James Glen I (who died in Hanover County, VA, cl762-63) and his descendants is the result of research by several of those descendants. Research began in 1889, and this volume, printed on acid-free paper, is a revised and expanded version of one first published in 1975 by the Glenn Family Association. Allied families include: Bowker, Bowles, Carlisle, Coleman, Dabnam, Dennie, Fant, Farr, Gilliam, Greer, Gregory, Harris, Hicks, Hill, Hopkins, Hurst, Johnson, Jones, Kennedy, Lyles, Macon, Matthews, May, McGeehee, McJunkin, Miller, Peake, Perrin, Peters, Rice, Sanders/Saunders, Sartor, Sims, Smith, Thomas, Tigner, Triplett, Walker, Warnock, Wilkes/Wilks, Williams, Wright, Young/Yongue, and others. References to other early Glenns in Virginia, as found in land patents, church records, etc., are included.

<u>CEMETERIES OF PANOLA COUNTY MISSISSIPPI</u> published by The Panola Historical and Genealogical Society. 1994. Soft back, 9x11, 308 pp. Full name index. Order from the Society, 129 Panola Ave., Batesville, MS 38606. \$15.00 plus \$3.00 p&h.

Cemeteries of Panola county were originally published by this society (known locally as Pan-Gens) as three smaller volumes in 1977, 1980 & 1981. The 1994 edition is the result of rechecking cemetries and up-dating all three previous editions, and the inclusion of fifteen black cemeteries. This listing is in alphabetical order by name of the cemetery and usually by names on the markers in them. The easy-to-follow arrangement is introduced by the surname in capital letters, followed by the list of individual graves. Lots are shown in the order of placement. Each section is introduced with a very brief history and the location of the cemetery. A map is included with the cemetery locations shown by number.

PANOLA REMEMBERS Education in a Southern Community A Historical and Sociological Study by C. E. Lindgren. 1994. Soft cover, 5x8, 225 pp. Order from The Panola County Historical & Genealogical Society, 129 Panola Avenue, Batesville, MS 38606. \$20.00 plus \$3.00 p&h.

PANOLA REMEMBERS traces education in the county from earliest times to the present, using personal interviews, as well as documents and newspapers from the past. The author discusses problems and progress over the years. Over 1,000 individuals who have worked in the schools and community are mentioned. This volume includes some genealogical information as well as historical material.

INDEX TO WILLS AND ADMINISTRATIONS OF ARKANSAS FROM THE EARLIEST TO 1900 compiled and edited by Mrs. James Harold Stevenson and Mrs. Edward Lynn Westbrooke. 1986. Hard cover, 8x11, 748 pp. Order from Mrs. Frank F. Sloan, 602 West Oak, Jonesboro, AR. 72401-3903. \$35.00 plus \$1.50 p&h.

For Arkansas researchers this massive compilation of wills and administrations from all Arkansas counties is a treasure chest of information. Except for Madison County, records are arranged by date, and in all counties, entries are listed by the surname of the testator. Undertaken by the state DAR in 1986, this project is the fruit of many chapters' labors. It is a necessity for libraries and serious Arkansas researchers, and a bargain at today's prices.

1870 U.S. FEDERAL CENSUS SULLIVAN COUNTY, TENNESSEE published by the Holston Territory Genealogical Society. 1994. Soft cover, 8x11. Indexed, 292 pp. Order from HTGS, P. O. Box 433, Bristol, VA 24203. \$25.00.

This census transcript includes all members of a household, age, occupation, and place of birth, if given. A map of Sullivan County showing the 1870 civil districts and a list of 1870 and 1994 postoffices are most helpful. The committee chairman recommends this transcription as a quick reference guideline to the original census on microfilm. Large print and generous spacing make this publication a joy to use.

THE GENEALOGIST'S ADDRESS BOOK by Elizabeth Petty Bentley. 3rd edition 1995. Soft cover, 8x11. Index to periodicals, newspapers and general index, 653 pp. Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD. \$34.95.

Compiled mainly from questionnaires, this third edition is a revised and enlarged version of the earlier volume. Names, addresses, phone numbers, contact persons and business hours are given for libraries, archives, genealogical societies, historical societies, government agencies, vital records offices, professional bodies, religious organizations, surname registries, research centers, periodicals, newspaper columns, publishers, booksellers, databases, bulletin boards and many other sources are given. Organized by national addresses, state addresses, ethnic and religious originations, and special resources, this volume presents a wide range of research possibilities.

THE JACOB ENGLEBRECHT MARRIAGE LEDGER OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND 1820-1890 compiled by Trudie Davis-Long and Edith O. Eader. 1994. Soft cover, 8x11. Full name index, 269 pp. Order from Paw Prints, Inc., P.O. Box 52, Monrovia, MD 21770. \$15.00 plus \$2.00 p&h. Maryland residents add 5% sales tax.

Jacob Engelbrecht, tailor and at one time mayor of Frederick, Maryland, kept notebooks in which he wrote his observations about life around him. These diaries became wet during a flood. Following the flood, he abstracted the marriages from the loose papers. The listing is alphabetical with husband, wife and date given. Additional information, such as 2nd wife, Penobscot Indians, and "Fair bride", is given. Well known individuals, including Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, are included.

<u>PROPER NAMES MASTER INDEX</u> edited by Frank R. Abate. 1994. Hardback, 9x11, 1915 pp. In two volumes. Order from Ominigraphics, Inc., Penobscot Building, Detroit, MI 48226. \$125.00/set.

This is a source used for locating proper names listed in other source books. The proper names included are not those of famous, historical persons, but rather names from mythology, The Bible, history, law or science etc. For example, under Chopin is given the code name PronPrpNam. A master index reveals that source to be "The Pronunciation of 10,000 Proper Names" by Mackey & Mackey. More than 60 such reference sources are included in this index. Librarians and researchers will know exactly which sources to consult for more detailed information on any of the 200,000 different proper names listed in these volumes.

WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE COUNTY COURT MINUTES MAY 1806-APRIL 1812 by Carol Wells. 1994. Soft cover, 5x8. Full name index, 227 pp. Order from Heritage Books, Inc., 1540-E Pointer Ridge Pl., Suite #300, Bowie, MD 20716. \$20.00 plus \$3.50 p&h.

There is no census for the years covered by this volume, therefore county records are especially important as the only source of information for the time period. These court minutes cover many aspects of frontier life. Among the subjects included are: disputes and lawsuits, road building, handling of insanity, illegitimacy, death, guardianships, apprenticeships, the remarriage of widows, delinquent taxes, public sales, deeds, depositions, and powers-of-attorney. The growth of the community is shown through the sale of town lots and the licensing of ordinaries, ferries, and mill sites. Unfortunately, the wealth of material requires greatly reduced type in order to produce a handy book.

These two volumes continue a series which links the names from the Drennen Roll with the names in the Guion Miller Applications. Each volume includes an explanation of the sources. Volume 4 contains material related to the Going Snake District and includes a map of the district. Volume 5 covers the Delaware District with a map of that region. The series will be completed in Volume 6, Tahlequah & Skin Bayou districts, which is scheduled to be in print this spring.

THE JAMESTOWNE SOCIETY REGISTER OF QUALIFYING SEVENTEENTH ANCESTORS. 1994. Soft cover, 5x8. Order from The Jamestowne Society, P.O. Box 17426, Richmond, VA 23226. \$10.00.

The Society has published this list of seventeenth century inhabitants of Jamestown, including their service and dates, to aid genealogical research and to promote the growth of the Society. Descent from one of the individuals listed is the basis for membership in the organization. All possible Jamestown residents are not known; others may be proved in time. As they are proved their names will be added to future registers.

DAVIDSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE, DEED BOOKS, "T" and "W", 1829-1835 by Mary Sue Smith. 1994. Soft cover, 5x8. Full name index, slave index and place index, 389 pp. Order from Heritage Books, Inc., 1540 E Pointer Ridge Pl., Suite #300, Bowie, MD 20716. \$28.50 plus \$3.50 p&h.

Taken from the original county deed books these transcripts furnish new indexes, which include all names recorded in each instrument. The inventories of personal property provide a unique picture of life during this period and family members are identified in a time when census records list only the head of the household. This volume is of particular interest to researchers of black families who lived in this era in this place.

"WAVES OF TIME THE ANCESTRY OF CLARK W. JENNINGS MD" by Clark W. Jennings. 1994. Hardback, 9x12, 968 pp. Order from C. W. Jennings, MD, 1364 5th Circle NW, Hickory, NC 28601. (704) 327-0707. \$60.00 plus \$6.00 p&h. \$3.60 sales tax (NC only).

Comparing "the passing of one generation and the arrival of the next with the continuous arrival of waves on a beach," Dr Jennings has compiled an enormous amount of family data into this handsome tome. His unique system arranges families alphabetically using an "Index-Surname Locater" at the beginning to tie the various families together, i.e. the chapter on the Baker family contains also Hannah, Whitaker and Jennings (Thompson) material.

Eighty seven surnames in his ancestry are traced, including Jennings, Johnson, Collett, Cooper, Whitaker, Sloan, Green, Guy, Wasson, Oldham, Temple, Hannah, Cox, Dyer, Amis, Turner, Hungerford, Smoote, Barton, Philpott, Posey, Stewart, Vivion, Thompson, Glass, Dupuy, Davis, and Daniel. The 65 pages which trace the ancestry of Bridget Hungerford, born in 1580, span 69 generations and include Alfred the Great and Charlemagne. Countless maps and charts clarify the text and many pictures make it interesting to read.

THE CARNEAL FAMILY OF VIRGINIA AND KENTUCKY by Mary H. Christian. 1994. Soft cover, 8x11. Full name index, 159 pp. \$14.50 plus \$2.00 p&h. GEORGE B. In THE CARNEAL FAMILY the ancestors, descendants and allied lines of the Rev. Josiah Carneal and his brother, Walker Carneal, are traced from the middle eighteenth century to the present day. The text is generously illustrated with photographs of descendants. Many family group sheets are reproduced. A chapter on Thomas Carneal's house in Covington, Kentucky, and his descendants is included.

GEORGE B. HITE'S LIBEL SUIT began when on April 3, 1882, the Louisville Courier-Journal published an article which alleged a liaison between Jesse James and Sarah Hite who was married to James's uncle. George B. Hite, Sarah's husband, sued the newspaper for defamation of character but lost. This volume includes James and Hite genealogical information in addition to the newspaper articles.

THE PENN ANCESTORS traces the line to c1500 and follows it through Col. Abram Penn & his son Abram Jr. to Lorine Penn Christian & the present generations. Abram Penn and his wife, Sally Critz, left Patrick Co. VA in 1820 to settle in Todd Co. KY. Biographical sketches, photographs, and family group sheets are used to explain the text. Charts illustrate relationship to William Penn, John Penn who signed the Declaration of Independence, and Robert Penn Warren.

<u>THE WHEELERS, A Northern Virginia Colonial Family With Descendants in Tennessee, Texas &</u> <u>Elsewhere</u> compiled by John Alexander Leo III. 1994. Soft cover, 8x11. Full name index, 234 pp. Order from Jack Leo, 5344 Cristfield Ct., Fairfax, VA 22032. (703) 603-5586 \$25.00 postpaid.

Beginning with John Wheeler who was transported to America in 1659, the Wheelers are traced through twelve generations to the present time. Many interesting tales are related: "William Wheler in 1728/9 petitioned the Baltimore County Court to be levy free as he was 7 years old and 'unable to get his living'." "Drummond Wheeler, who was born in 1799 in Virginia, was married and raised two families in Tennessee before migrating to Mississippi, where he married his third wife in 1847 and had a family there with her." His reason for leaving Tenn. was the passage of a law against "prize-fighting." This volume is completed with photographs of family members and a descendants chart listing all known descendants of John Wheeler, some of whom are not mentioned in the text. Footnotes give sources and references to other Wheeler family material.

THE COMPLETE ANCESTRY OF TENNESSEE WILLIAMS compiled by John A. Brayton. 1993. Hardback, 6x9. Full name index, 489 pp. Order from John A. Brayton, 1001 S. Marshall St., Suite 53, Winston-Salem, NC 27101. \$35.00 postpaid plus \$2.45 sales tax for NC residents.

Tennessee Williams' plays reflect a thorough knowledge of Southern character and manners, but his ancestry is revealed as mainly from outside the South. Dominated by New England and German/Lutheran immigrants, his background has only a few Virginia roots. This welldocumented volume traces Williams' ancestry from the sixteenth century to the present. Well-known individuals with whom Williams shares ancestors are listed. They include: Dorothea Dix, Lizzie Borden, Herman Melville, Zelda Fitzgerald, Herbert Hoover, Thomas Jefferson, Franklin Roosevelt, and the Princess of Wales. Mr. Brayton says "...with the advent of... published abstracts of county records, it is as possible to uncover the truth of various family tradition which have persisted for several centuries as it has been to debunk them." The volume is completed with an appendix of related families and a twenty-one page bibliography. It is to be followed with an addendum concerning the ancestry of Gen. James Robertson of Tennessee back to the Robinsons of Colonial Henrico Co. Virginia.

<u>BIBLIOGRAPHIC CHECKLIST OF AFRICAN AMERICAN NEWSPAPERS</u> by Barbara K. Henritze. 1995. Hardback, 8x11. Bibliography title index, 206 pp. Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., 1001 N. Calvert, Baltimore, MD 21202. \$35.00.

This list of 5,539 newspapers which were owned, published, edited, and read by African Americans is arranged in tabular format under headings which include title, city and state of publication. These newspapers were drawn from major bibliographic sources and include every newspaper that has served African Americans since 1827. This source is useful in researching social and cultural history as well as political history and genealogy.

ANTEBELLUM ARKANSAS: TRAMMELL FAMILIES, Genealogical Sketches of Trammell Families in Arkansas, 1807-1850 by Betty Trammell Snyder. 1994. Soft cover 8x11. Bibliography, 238 pp. Order from Betty Trammell Snyder, 2303 17th St., Lubbock, TX 79401-4436. \$23.00 postpaid.

Fifteen families who came into Arkansas before 1850 are traced from Virginia through Tennessee and Kentucky into Arkansas. Maps, federal census records, photographs, letters, wills, and charts illustrate the text. The story continues up to 1900, when possible, taking into consideration the impact of the Civil War on Southern families as shown through the families in this account. A handsome coat-of-arms in color is depicted on the spiralbound cover.

OLSCHWANGER JOURNAL, Fall/Winter, 1993/5754, editor Anna Olswanger. Soft cover, 8x11, 136 pp. Order from Anna Olswanger, 7117 Harps Mill Road, Raleigh, NC 2715-5323. \$40.00 pp.

This third and final volume of the journal is the result of ten years research. Illustrated with photographs and documents this edition included letters, interviews, family news and a family director. The years 1866 to 1942 are covered.
